### Grace and Peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,

The month of May is one filled with many Holy Days and Holidays. We have Memorial Day, Mother's Day, May Day, Cinco De Mayo, Star Wars Day, and many others. Of course, an often overlooked one is St. Matthias Day on May 14th. Matthias is, of course, one of the 12 apostles. Not the original ones, but the first replacement. Now, I find him very interesting for exactly that reason. The mission of Christ is so important that it goes beyond the first generation of disciples. When Judas betrays them and Christ, they do not give up or even "retire his number" so to speak. They realize that the mission must continue and so they replace him. They don't just do this on their own of course, but they do their best to make wise decisions by choosing two replacements, Joseph and Matthias, and then casting lots to let the Holy Spirit decide which of these two are destined to replace Judas.

Although the Bible leaves the story of Matthias there with his being chosen as one of the 12, other texts record that Matthias first preaches in Judea. From there, tradition has Matthias going to Ethiopia where he preaches until he is crucified there. Although relatively little is known about Matthias, various traditions have him preaching in other places. What is known about Matthias is that he faithfully carries on the ministry given to him. He is interesting for exactly the reason that he apparently is not actually that interesting. He is a faithful worker in Christ's kingdom, and although he is the first replacement, the church will continue to need people like him to step up and lead the church in their day and age. Many of them will not be recorded in the Bible, and their deeds though very impactful to those around them will go unknown to greater church history. (But are remembered by God). Just today Tim was cleaning up an old file-cabinet and found church records from the early 90's. They had ministries that I didn't know about and many of us probably don't remember, yet they built and sustained the church throughout the years. So, in this way he is a patron saint to all of us who have gotten ministries from others and then faithfully carry them on and help them to thrive and grow. Although we don't have just 12 disciples anymore, the church is made up of people willing to step up and take on those ministries of the church in our day and age. God is calling us to be Matthias stepping up to committees, ministries and carrying for one another in our day and age.




